

J. Ford Forsyth and Fred Schneider certify that:

They are the President and Secretary, respectively, of The University Club of Claremont, a California nonprofit mutual benefit corporation. The following Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of the corporation has been approved by the Board of Directors of the corporation:

1. Article II of the Articles of Incorporation is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

II. PURPOSES

This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for educational and/or charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The primary purposes of the corporation are to support and encourage education in the community, including the education of the members of the corporation.

2. Paragraphs (a) and (b) of Article VI of the Articles of Incorporation are amended to read in their entirety as follows:

- (a) The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to educational and/or charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof, or to the benefit of any private person.
- (b) On the dissolution or winding up of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment of, or provision for payment of, all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for educational and/or charitable purposes and which has established its tax-exempt status under Internal Revenue Code Section 501 (c)(3).
- 3. Paragraph (d) of Article VI of the Articles of Incorporation is deleted.
- 4. Article VIII of the Articles of Incorporation is deleted.
- 5. As required by Corporations Code Section 7813.5, this Amendment has been approved by the members. The vote of the members was taken at a duly held meeting at which a quorum of the members were present, and the majority of those present voted in favor of the Amendment. The affirmative votes in favor of the Amendment also constituted a

majority of the required quorum.

6. As further required by Corporations Code Section 7813.5, the fairness of the Amendment to the members has been approved by the Commissioner of Corporations pursuant to Section 25142, said approval having been made on July 3, 1984.
